Background: The Catholic community supports the universal right of every human being to receive an education. This right is fundamental to our faith and beliefs. We believe society has the responsibility to provide and ensure that the necessary resources and commitment are provided to schools.

POLICY: The Board will provide access to education programs for every Catholic student who has attained the age of 6 (as of December 31st) but has not yet attained the age of 22, provided the student or his/her parents/guardians reside within the Prince Albert Roman Catholic Separate School Division No. 6 boundaries.
