RE: STF Sanctions - Indefinite Provincewide Work to Rule

Dear Parents/Guardians, Students, and Staff,

The STF has indicated an indefinite provincewide work to rule job action. As a result, we will operate the alternate schedule on Wednesday, April 10, 2024, with the school day ending 20 minutes early, as we have done on Monday and Tuesday this week. However, starting Thursday, April 11, 2024, we will be moved to the New Early Dismissal Schedule* below until job action ends.

The following schedule will be effective Thursday, April 11, 2024, and until further notice:

- **An earlier dismissal schedule*** will be implemented to maintain student safety due to the impact on noon supervision, and schools will dismiss the students early. The STF members will take their duty-free period at an adjusted assigned time. Please refer to the schedule below regarding the updated dismissal times. Bus schedules will also be adjusted.
- **School doors will be open 15 minutes before the instructional day begins and closed 15 minutes after the instructional day ends. Students can no longer be on school grounds/property before or after these times.** Supervision is restricted to those times as STF members have withdrawn their supervision services beyond these times.

- We recommend that all students bring lunches/snacks that can be easily consumed at their desks during the school day and break times.
- All extracurricular and school-led activities are cancelled (before, during lunch and after school).
- The elementary band will operate with an altered schedule
- Teachers will provide instructional support via phone, Edsby, Microsoft Teams meetings or in-person support for instructional support. Speak to the teacher to make arrangements.

High School:

- **An earlier dismissal schedule*** - The school and bus times will be adjusted until further notice. See the schedule below.
- We recommend that all students bring lunches/snacks that can be easily consumed at their desks during the school day and break times.
- The Cafeteria will be open for lunch options that will be easily consumed throughout the day.
- All extracurricular and school-led activities are cancelled before, during lunch and after school (for example, and not limited to school sports, school clubs, performing arts, graduation preparations, open houses, etc.).
- High School classes scheduled outside of school hours will occur as regularly scheduled.
