What are the purposes of grading?

- Communicate the achievement status of students to parents, (students), and others.
- Provide information that students can use for self-evaluation.
- Select, identify, or group students for certain educational paths or programs
- Provide incentives to learn
- Evaluate the effectiveness of instructional programs

Grading Practices/Principles

Accurate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Use triangulation or varied evidence ○ Give greater consideration to recent learning ○ Individual student achievement
Meaningful	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Plan for assessment based on competencies and curriculum outcomes and indicators ○ Gather and document evidence based on curricular expectations ○ Use collections of evidence to identify best learning and conversations about learning and instruction
Consistent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Use competencies rubrics, Personal & Social Growth(PSG) rubrics, Factors Affecting Achievement(FAA) rubrics and descriptors on which to base values given.
