Kindergarten: The Prince Albert Catholic School Division is committed to providing high quality learning environments for all of our students. Kindergarten programming is offered in English, French and Michif. Our Kindergarten program strives to support children's readiness for learning by providing programming that fosters learning through play, exploration and discovery. Children who are 5 years old by December 31, 2025 are invited to register their children for the 2025-26 school year at the school in their attendance area. There are spaces available for the current school year for children who turned 5 years old before December 31, 2024.

English Prekindergarten: Prekindergarten is a welcoming environment that encourages children to create, explore, discover, and experience wonder in the world around them. Children who are 3 or 4 years old are invited to apply for the 2025-26 school year at the school in your attendance area. There are spaces available for the current school year for children who are 3 or 4 years old.

ELIS: Early Learning Intensive Supports are available as part of our Prekindergarten Programming. ELIS is a program for young children who require additional or intensive supports. Supports are provided through a collaborative team approach to meet individual needs and to promote strengths for learning and participation.

Did you know... The Prince Albert Catholic School Division operates on funds received from local property taxation and provincial government grants. To ensure your property taxes are supporting your Catholic Separate School Division, you must declare your school support as "Separate" on your Annual Property Assessment Notice and Tax Bill.
