- Prince Albert Catholic School Division serves 3160 students.
- Prince Albert Catholic School Division serves approx. 1670 families.
- Prince Albert Catholic School Division has 7 schools within 5 Parishes.
- Our high school offers all SHSAA sports, including Football, Soccer, Volleyball, Wrestling, Cross-Country, Track and Field, and Basketball
- École St. Mary High School offers high-performance athletic programs for hockey, volleyball, wrestling, football, basketball, and general sports
- École St. Mary High School had 197 graduates in 2025! The Prince Albert Catholic School Division not only had a marked improvement from previous years, but we outperformed the provincial averages.
- Prince Albert Catholic School Division elementary schools just finished CROSS-COUNTRY, and currently, each school has a VOLLEYBALL team playing in our PAC Elementary Athletics.
