Background:

The Prince Albert Roman Catholic Board of Education is committed to providing quality learning resources that promote the fair and equitable treatment of all people regardless of race, ethnicity, gender, age and physical or mental levels of ability. However, occasionally questions may arise from parents, students, staff or community members regarding the suitability and content of certain resources.

POLICY:

The Director of Education or designate and/or the professional staff shall decide on the suitability of learning resources according to established guidelines and procedures that have been approved by the Board of Education.

Guidelines:

- 1. If a community member, parent/guardian, staff member or student raises a concern regarding suitability of any learning resource, a school administrator shall investigate and provide appropriate information and explanation with a view of resolving the issue raised. The administrator shall subsequently report the pertinent information and action taken to the Director of Education or designate.
- 2. If the individual concerned is not satisfied with the administrator's decision and wishes to request a formal reconsideration, the following procedures shall be followed:
 - a) Ask the community member, parent/guardian, staff member or student to complete the form "Request for Reconsideration of Learning Resources". (Appendix A) and forward the request to the Director of Education or designate.
 - b) The Director of Education or designate will establish and chair a school division committee comprised of a school administrator, two or more teacher librarians, teacher representative(s) and other educational experts deemed appropriate.
 - c) The Director of Education or designate, after consulting with the school division committee, is responsible to make a final decision that either:
 - (i) retains the resource
 - (ii) retains the learning resource but with restricted use
 - (iii) withdraws the learning resource from use in particular grade levels
 - (iv) withdraws the resource from all schools in the school division

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- d) The Director of Education or designate shall inform the community member, parent/guardian, staff member or student and the Director of Education of the decision.
- 3. A community member, parent/guardian, staff member or student who wishes to appeal the final decision of the Director of Education or designate shall provide written correspondence to the Board of Education chairperson and Director of Education. The Board of Education will decide on:
 - a) whether or not to review the Director of Education or designate decision
 - b) the process and participants involved
 - c) the communication of the final decision to the community member, parent/guardian, staff member or student.
