RE: Return to Regular School Scheduling and Operations

Dear Parents/Guardians, Students, and Staff,

We have been notified that the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation (STF) will resume all professional and voluntary services; therefore, we will resume all regular school scheduling and operations effective April 12, 2024, at 11:59 pm tonight. Resumption includes student support, extracurricular activities, noon supervision, and other voluntary services.

Effective Monday, April 15, 2024, and until further notice, our schools will operate the Regular School Schedule.

Should any of these eventualities occur, the Board of Education will notify students and parents as far in advance as possible to ensure the safety and well-being of our children/youth.
